

Maxine Keogh Scholarship Requirements

Criteria for Application:

To be eligible for the \$1000 Maxine Keogh Scholarship, you must meet the below listed criteria:

- Must be a Junior at EWU enrolled in the HCAD program
- Must be employed 30 hours per week or more
- Demonstrate financial need
- In good academic standing maintaining a GPA of 3.2 or greater
- Demonstrate leadership and active involvement at school and/or in the community
- All applicants must be eligible to work without sponsorship after graduation. Preference will be given to residents of Washington State

Maxine Keogh Scholars are students who demonstrate their desire and ability to become successful in life through hard work and determination.

How to Apply:

To apply for the Maxine Keogh Scholarship, create a short video addressing the below topics. Include a URL to your video and email it to Dr. Lynn Anidi at lanidi.ewu.edu. Dr. Anidi will then forward the video to the HCAD advisory committee who will select a student to receive the scholarship. Please keep the video to five minutes or less.

Topics to address:

1. How are you committed to making a difference in your community and in the lives of others
2. Use this video to give us more information about who you are and why you want to be a recipient of the Maxine Keogh Scholarship. Please discuss any personal obstacles, hardships, and/or extraordinary life circumstances that you are currently experiencing or have overcome. What strengths, skills, or resources have helped you to face these challenges? Tell us about your short and long-term educational and life goals. Please also take this opportunity to share something about yourself that will help us to better understand your personality, character or interests.
3. Describe your professional objective and explain how the HCAD degree will assist you in achieving these objectives.

Applying should be fun, but to have a better shot at winning, the applicant should try to make their video stand out from others. Be creative! The video can be entertaining or informative and professional, but it should be unique and interesting. The video that can best capture all the above in under five minutes will win the scholarship.
