The information below outlines the transferable courses at Portland Community College to meet Eastern Washington University's Dental Hygiene Prerequisites and Breadth Area Core Requirements (BACR's).

Priority Science Prerequisite Courses

These courses must be completed or in process at the time of application:

- **If applying to Fall 2024 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2023
- **If applying to Fall 2025 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2024
- **If applying to Fall 2026 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2025
