### Priority Science Prerequisite Courses

These courses must be completed or in process at the time of application:

*\*\*If applying to Fall 2024 Admissions, the 3 courses must be completed by the end of Fall Semester 2023*

*\*\*If applying to Fall 2025 Admissions, the 3 courses must be completed by the end of Fall Semester 2024*

*\*\*If applying to Fall 2026 Admissions, the 3 courses must be completed by the end of Fall Semester 2025*
