Priority Science Prerequisite Courses

These courses must be completed or in process at the time of application:

***If applying to Fall 2024 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2023*

***If applying to Fall 2025 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2024*

***If applying to Fall 2026 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2025*
