 Course of Study - MSW Advanced Standing Program – Part-Time**

The 51-credit advanced standing program for part-time students provides qualified BSW/BASW graduates a waiver for the MSW foundation curriculum. Advanced standing students begin their studies with a summer seminar and then join a current cohort of students to complete the MSW specialized practice curriculum. Part-time programs use a hybrid format which includes partial in-person class sessions and partial online modules. For specific program format, refer to the program description.
