- Both the Donor and Foundation representative must sign and date the document.
- If the Donor chooses to complete an IRS Form 8283 "Noncash Charitable Contributions Appraisal Summary" the Director of Financial Services from the Foundation will sign Part 1 certifying acceptance of the gift.
- If the Foundation sells the gift(s) within two years after receiving it, a Form 8282 "Donee information return" must be filed with the IRS, by the Foundation, within ninety days after the sale. A copy of the Form 8282 will be sent to the donor, as well as with the IRS.
