
EWU established a foundation that would create and grow endowed funds to provide scholarships for current and future students, while advancing the mission of EWU.

One of my favorite aspects of being involved in the EWU Foundation Board is the constant stories of inspiration. People from all walks of life – and not just Eastern walks of life – give generously to support EWU.

Something happens

now, or maybe something happened in the past, that is near and dear to their hearts – and that inspires giving. In return, their gifts positively impact generations of Eagles for years to come.

Take, for example, the widow, now in her 80s, whose beloved husband obtained his master's degree from EWU and loved football. She and family members created a football scholarship in his memory. Or, the woman who wanted to honor her mother, an elementary school teacher born and raised on a small farm near Cheney who attended Cheney Normal School. She started a scholarship in her mother's name to acknowledge the positive impact Eastern made for her and the entire family.

In another act of generosity, a University of Washington graduate who is a Seattle real estate developer created an endowed scholarship at EWU to support disadvantaged students. He asked that the scholarship be used to keep students enrolled so that they can complete their degrees.

Closer to home, a local family foundation selected EWU to receive numerous \$4,000 scholarships to ensure students who earn their AA degrees from Washington's community colleges have a pathway to earn their bachelor's degrees at Eastern.

There are hundreds of similar stories just like these that inspire me. These stories make me forever grateful to the hundreds and thousands of people who continue to give to EWU so that Eastern can continue to expand opportunities for personal transformation through excellence in learning.

INVESTMENT REPORT AND COMPARATIVE ENDOWMENT PERFORMANCE

ENDOWMENT POOL

Funds in the EWU Foundation endowment are managed as a single investment. Like an individual who invests in a mutual fund, an endowed fund purchases units in the endowment pool and participates in a per-unit allocation of investment pool earnings and distributions. This investment and comparative endowment performance report illustrates the performance of the pooled investment for the fiscal year July 1, 2020-June 30, 2021.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES AND OVERSIGHT

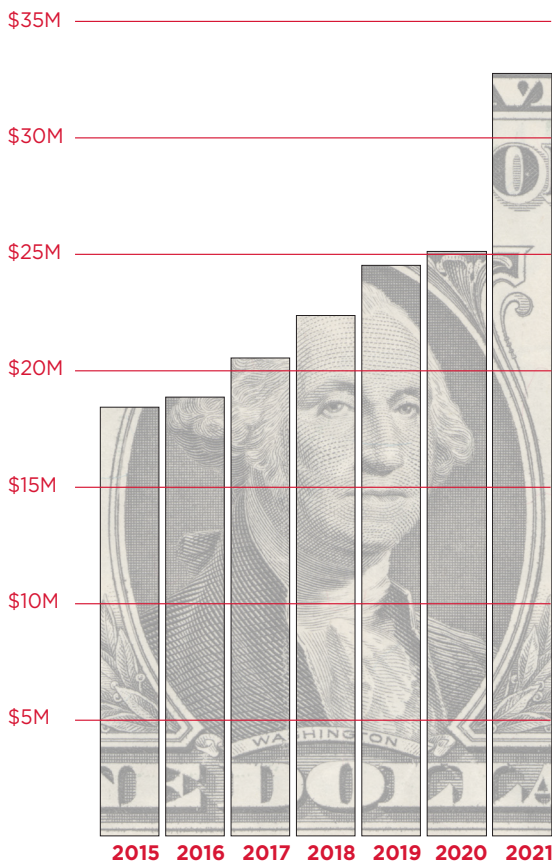
The EWU Foundation manages the investment pool with direct oversight by the EWU Foundation investment committee. The committee actively works with Northern Trust Institutional Investment Services to select asset

allocation and achieve a well-diversified asset mix that balances maximum return with acceptable risk over time. Northern Trust, founded in 1889, has core principles of service, expertise and integrity.

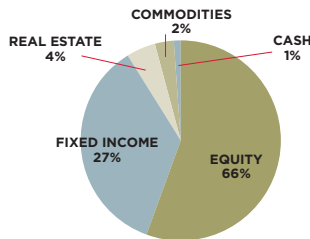
INVESTMENT AND DISTRIBUTION PERFORMANCE FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2020 TO JUNE 30, 2021

- Endowment designated gifts in fiscal year 2021 of over \$3 million

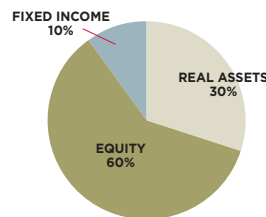
VALUE ENDOWMENT MARKET VALUE



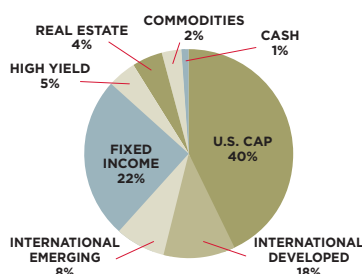
ALLOCATION RANGE

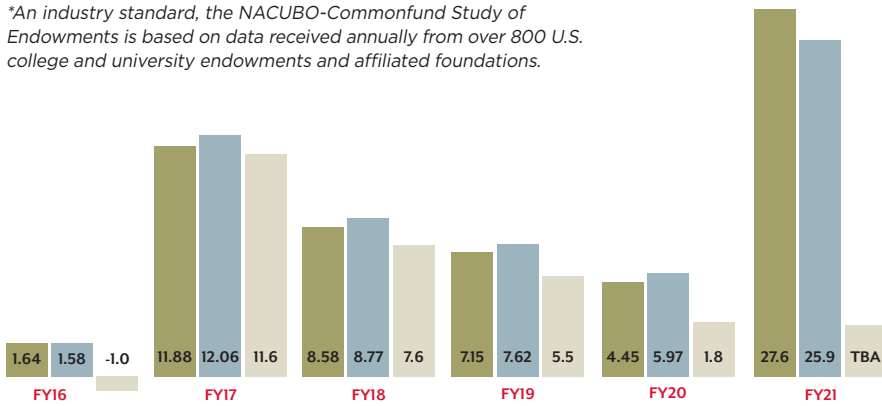
The Foundation endowment investment goal is to match the return of a benchmark consisting of public market indices weighted to asset allocation targets.

- NACUBO-COMMONFUND * STUDY OF ENDOWMENTS

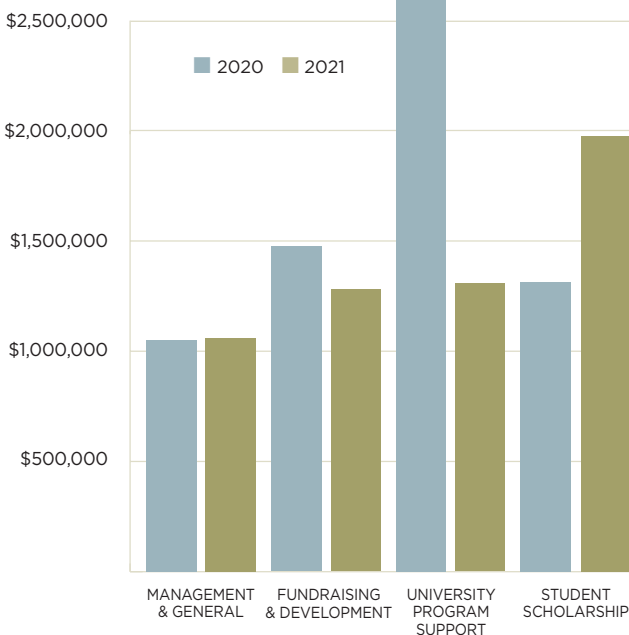

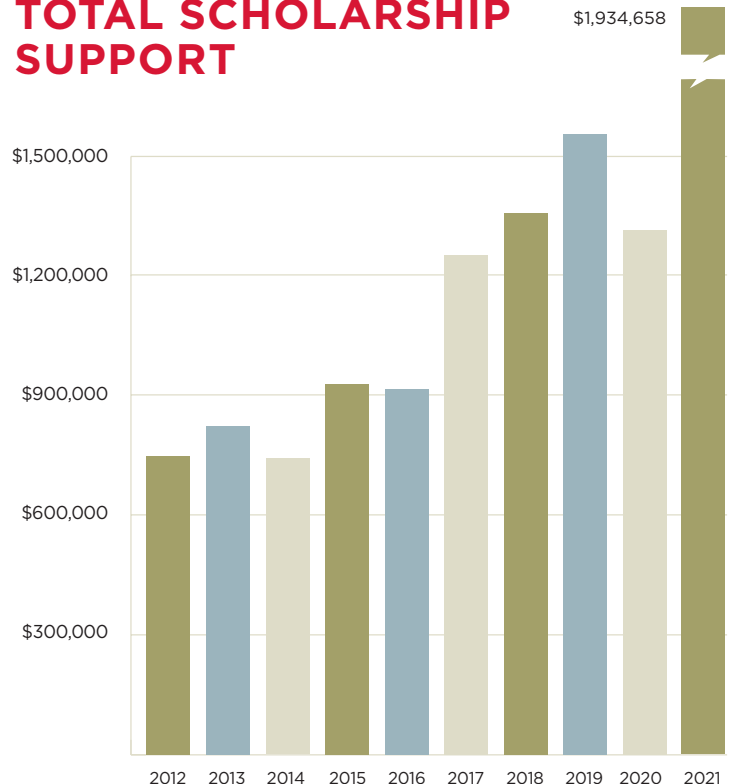

On GivingTuesday 2020, generous donors gave more than \$83,380. Some helped three scholarship funds reach endowment, which means they will soon begin providing scholarship support to deserving students in need.

On that global day of giving, EWU community members supported the Empowering Women Upward Fund to help women, age 35 and older, earn degrees; the Bill Youngs Endowment, which supports student research projects in history and environmental science; and the Chicana/o/x Studies Endowment, which strengthens the community and provides scholarships for students' tuition, books and other expenses.

Alumni, faculty, staff and community members founded the Chicana/o/x Studies Endowment who say the social engagement and strong relationships within the program

made their experiences unforgettable. This scholarship fund ensures future students have the opportunity to earn degrees in that environment.

“As a first-generation student, it was really important to me that I find support,” said Elsa Chávez, a senior majoring in political science and Spanish. “It can be difficult for anyone, especially people of color, to find the kind of support they need. There are definitely groups on campus who are actively working to provide support and safe spaces for us.”

On Giving Joy Day 2021, Eastern's 139th birthday, Eagle Nation, including our business partners, spread joy through kindness, community philanthropy and service. Gifts totaling more than \$170,000 for grants, scholarships, internships, strong academic programs, competitive athletics and more are helping students to “Eagle On.”
