However, a BA in Education with an endorsement in the related language or BA in the related language will be considered. Newly hired teachers need to comply with the Washington State requirements in regard to the ACTFL (American Council of Teachers of Foreign Languages) language proficiency. They need to score Advanced-Low or higher in both the oral (OPI or OPIc) and writing versions (WPT) of the ACTFL proficiency exams, offered through Language Testing International. This requirement does not apply to teachers hired prior to 2010 as this required was implemented in 1/1/2010
